



New services for authors in the Electronic Journals Library (EZB)

The new functions at a glance:

- ▶ **Contact information:** Get direct contact to your institution's publication service and information on invoice processing.
- ▶ **Publication costs:** Find out the average publication costs actually paid for journals via OpenAPC.
- ▶ **Possibilities for grants:** Find out about the funding options for publication costs at your institution.
- ▶ **Journal categories:** Filter journals according to the EZB categories like *Diamond Open Access*, *DOAJ seal* or *Data Journal*.
- ▶ **Information on publishing:** Get journal-specific publishing details from the DOAJ, including information on:
 - Article Processing Charges
 - Link to submission guidelines
 - Duration until publication
 - Information on the review process
 - License of the publications
 - Accepted languages
- ▶ **Information on secondary publication:** Use important notes on how to provide your already published research results free of charge.





New services for authors

You know the EZB as a service for the effective use of scholarly full-text journals on the internet. Additional functions have now been added to the EZB to provide researchers with targeted support when publishing.

Why is this important?

The EZB helps you to compare publication costs transparently, to make cost-conscious decisions and make the most of funding opportunities.
